Cabo San Lucas, MEXICO (July 31, 2018) – We're proud to share that [The Resort at Pedregal](#), a AAA Five-Diamond, Forbes Five-Star Resort in Cabo San Lucas, has received the esteemed Certification of Energy Management Systems award, UNE-EN ISO 50001: 2011, from AENOR, for the second year in a row, and is now the only resort to hold the certification in Latin America. ISO 50001 helps to conserve resources and improve environmental management by supporting organizations and resorts that use resources more efficiently through energy management programs.

ISO 50001:2011 is based on the management system model of continual improvement standards and outlines the requirements that an Energy Management System must have to make systematic enhancements in energy performance. In receiving this certification, The Resort at Pedregal has once again met the requirements of developing a policy for efficient energy use, identified growth opportunities and implemented processes to continually improve on-property energy management.

"Improving our sustainability is an initiative our entire team takes part in," said Fernando Flores, general manager of The Resort at Pedregal. "We pride ourselves in continually developing new ways to utilize resources efficiently and hope our recertification inspires others within the industry to evaluate and develop strategies to decrease energy usage to better our environment."

Energy conservation efforts for 2018 include using 3.02 percent less electricity, equal to 144,923 kwh, per guest when compared to the previous year, and 25 percent less gas per guest consumed than in 2017, equal to 199,046 liters. The resort has a Green Committee that internally monitors energy usage and audits current practices to ensure they maintain efficiency. Current standards on property include a sensor on each terrace door that automatically shuts off the cold water valve when the guest leaves the guestroom door ajar, and a Pool Efficiency Project that helps the resort use only three high-efficiency variable speed pumps (saving up to 50 percent energy), three electrical heaters, and three gas heaters to heat

the water for each plunge pool. New initiatives implemented by the Green Committee within the past year included changes on air conditioning, installation of gas controllers and new laundry systems.
