## The Resort at Paws Up, Montana

It's a working cattle ranch set in a luxurious backdrop. Adventures include a sky line aerial adventure park (including a quick drop from 55 feet in the air) to ATV rides across the vast property. The Resort at Paws Up is an unforgettable adventure that sits on 37,000 acres in the heart of Blackfoot Valley in western Montana that is steeped in history and holds many awards to date, including Best Family Resort.

Between the wilderness work-shops to horseback riding to water activities to hot air ballooning, it never feels like camping—only like a welcome break surrounded by luxury accommodations, delicious food and beautiful landscape, with green initiatives throughout the entire property. While wrangling cows on horseback may not seem like an enjoyable way to spend an afternoon, it is surprising just how wonderful the challenge can be.

Paws Up offers accommodations for a maximum of 225 guests in 36 glamorous safari-style tents (seasonally) and 28 luxurious vacation homes, ranging from the two-bedroom Meadow Homes and three-bedroom Wilderness Estates to the charming, private, four-bedroom Morris Ranch House.



Every year, the range of exclusive, seasonal events featuring experts from all over the country only enhance the lavish ranch resort's existing offerings.

### SEPTEMBER 21-24: Montana Master Chefs

For the last 10 years, Paws Up has been featuring a steady stream of James Beard Award winners, "Top Chef" stars and other highly esteemed chefs. ## Ko'a Kea Hotel and Resort, Kaua'i, Hawaii

Sitting on the island of Kaua'i at Po'ipū Beach, Ko'a Kea Hotel and Resort is the island's closest hotel to the Pacific Ocean. Named as the Top Resort Hotel in Hawaii and No. 48 on the list of the Top 100 Hotels in the World, according to *Travel + Leisure* World's Best Awards 2017, it's in the perfect location on one of Kaua'i's most swimmable beaches, popular for snorkeling, kayaking, surfing and other water sports. The hotel's serene saltwater pool is available for those who want to stay close under a cabana for the day.

The 121-room resort is also nearby to ocean cliff-top trails, Old Koloa Town, golf courses, and natural sites such as Spouting Horn and the National Tropical Botanical Garden.

Horseback riding is available at CJM Country Stables to ride along Kaua'i's south shore and into hidden valleys and panoramic views in the Maha'ulepū area. Many local companies offer ATV rides through the terrain to see the island, as well as land where multiple movies have been filmed disguised as countries all over the world.

A trip to Hawaii wouldn't be complete without rum tasting. The Koloa Rum Tasting Room, which makes all their rum right on site, offers every 30 minutes a splash of dark rum, spice rum, coconut rum, rum cake and rum fudge sauce to your palate for the day.

## The Resort at Pedregal, Cabo San Lucas, Mexico



Being greeted at 4 p.m. each day with complementary fresh guacamole and chips in the rooms at The Resort at Pedregal is a delicious way to round out the afternoons under the sunny Mexican sky. Named the No. 1 Resort in Mexico by *Travel + Leisure* in 2017, and No. 28 in the world for best hotels, the guest service is superior.

At the southernmost tip of the Mexico's Baja California Peninsula, the 24-acre site sits where the Pacific Ocean

meets the Sea of Cortez, close to where Cabo Arch and Land's End, the legendary rock formations. With a total of 113 rooms, each has at least one plunge pool on its private terrace. All of the rooms offer an ocean view, complete with binoculars for whale watching; and the brand new 4,391-square-foot plush two-level Casa Bella Vista offers stunning views from floor-to-ceiling windows.

Zen doesn't just have to come from the ocean. The eight treatment suites at Luna y Mar Spa float on the secluded spa pool with direct access to waterfalls. Aquatherapy demonstrations encourage guests to relaxation states and energy flow meditation in the spa pool each morning lets the flow of the body come into balance.

There is no shortage of fresh food. Four restaurants serve fare made from traditional recipes with modern interpretations. With tequila tastings, a Mexican wine tour and signature cocktail classes at Don Manuel's Bar, there's no shortage of spirits either.

Speaking of spirits, but of a different kind, The Resort at Pedregal hosts Dia

de Muertos with an authentic Mexican celebration every November with culinary delights, music and dancing. On this day of Dia de Muertos, it is customary to celebrate and remember those who have departed.

In November, the resort hosts a traditional Thanksgiving holiday celebration. Come December, the Christmas holiday and New Year are cheered in with five-course tasting menus, circus-inspired acrobatic performances and more.

The Resort at Pedregal is perfect for a romantic getaway or a family adventure. Between classes for Spanish, cooking, and wellness and fitness, finding time to sit by the pool almost needs to be scheduled. The resort makes sure there is no time for the kids to be bored with activities such as puppet making, art classes with materials such as recycled shampoo and lotion bottles, piñata making and a treasure hunt, to name just a few. There is truly no need to leave the resort. In fact, guests may never want to go home. ■
